# Whiting Sea-Lok Door Seal Installation Guide

**Required Materials and Tools:** 

- 1. Seals
- 2. Corner tabs (Whiting Part#:ML1823)
- 3. Sea-Lok adhesive sealant (Whiting Part#:ML2001)
- 4. Razor knife
- 5. Hammer or Mallet
- 6. Wood block

#### Step Two: \_



Apply a 3/16" diameter bead of Sea-Lok adhesive sealant at mid point on each inside wall of rigid channel. Using the same adhesive sealant, apply beads to corner fiber tab. Note: complete next step within 10 minutes of sealant application.

#### Step One: \_



Cut replacement edge extrusion to fit (measure carefully). A small (1/8") expansion gap is required at each end.

### Step Three: \_\_\_\_\_



Immediately mount gasket on panel by spreading rigid legs of edging at one end and push onto panel. Using a wood block and hammer or mallet, tap into place progressively. Repeat block and hammer or mallet procedure several times the entire length of edge to assure snug installation.

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






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## Step Four:



Install corner angle at all corners of edge. If the angle is wider than the panel thickness, cut to fit. Apply a 3/16" bead of adhesive on the inside of both sides of corner. Add a small bead of caulk to seal the top and bottom of the corner angle.



#### Step Six:



Apply a bead of caulk to the intersection of tabs and miters; smooth with your finger.

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Finish corners by applying Sea-Lok corner tab adhesive to both mitered points and the back (concave) side of the corner tabs (outside tab is longer than the inside tab). Wait until both surfaces are tacky (see instructions on can) and press firmly to achieve bond, being sure tab is centered over joint.

\*\*Note: Avoid use of nails, screws or staples



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
