## Subject: Wabco Change to iABS Valve Model

This bulletin is to inform Stoughton Trailers customers of a running change being made to suspensions specified with Wabco Anti-lock Braking Systems. Wabco is discontinuing the TCSII valve in favor of the iABS model valve. Stoughton will begin installing iABS valves once inventory is depleted of the TCSII models. This change is effective across all Stoughton product lines.

Since iABS supports 5V Controller Area Network (CAN) communication ports and generic input/output (GIO) ports, every single trailer can become intelligent and connected to a telematics unit without a system upgrade.

Other features of the iABS system include:

- Built on proven concept of current generation (TCS-II). Optimized, robust and integrated design.
- Smaller application space due to improved cable orientation and thinner cable diameters
- No need for external cable connection between ECU and valve
- Reduced cable connection complexity and improved flexibility leads to easier vehicle installation
- Range of 20 optional Intelligent Trailer functions helping to improve safety and efficiency
- Multi Voltage for diverse application conditions ranging from 8 to 32V
- Improved flexibility Tank and frame mounting possibility
- New ISO 26262 safety standards compliant

Wabco has provided a training guide and an instruction manual for the iABS system.
